Symptom	Viral / PCR COVID test (rapid tests not accepted)	When can my child return to the PJCC?
Fever	REQUIRED	After emailing negative COVID test results and child is symptom-free for 48 hours without the use of medication.

Shortness of Breath	<p>1 symptom = Consult Medical Provider</p> <p>2 or more symptoms (including rash) = COVID test required</p>	<p>If a child has 2 or more of these symptoms simultaneously, a COVID test is required. After emailing negative COVID test results AND child is symptom-free for 48 hours without the use of medication, they may return to campus.</p> <p>If experiencing 1 symptom, medical provider consultation required to evaluate testing. If the medical provider does not recommend covid test, the child may return after they are symptom-free for 48 hours without the use of medication.</p>

Rash	<p>Consult Medical Provider</p> <p>If another symptom above is present, COVID test required.</p>	<p>If a child has a rash and no other symptoms, they must have a note from their medical provider clearing them to return to a group setting.</p> <p>If they have a rash and any of the other above listed symptoms, a COVID test is required. After emailing negative COVID test results AND a note from their medical provider clearing them to return to a group setting, they may return to campus.</p>

Other Common Communicable Diseases	Action Steps	When can my child return to the PJCC?
Hand-Foot-Mouth	Consult Medical Provider	Child must be in good health, follow treatment plan as determined by their medical provider AND have a note from their medical provider clearing them to return to a group setting.
Fifth's Disease (slap cheek)

Strep Throat	Consult Medical Provider	Child must be in good health, follow treatment plan as determined by their medical provider, be on antibiotics for at least 24 hours, AND have a note from their medical provider clearing them to return to a group setting.
Conjunctivitis (pink eye)		
Lice	Lice Treatment	Confirm treatment AND child must be checked by Administration to ensure children are egg and nit free before returning.

It is at the discretion of the PJCC administration whether children may enter the campus and we will err on the side of caution regarding any potential symptoms observed.
